**Instructions**

1. Mark the oval to the left of the name of your choice. 
2. Any mark or writing outside the spaces provided for voting may void the entire ballot.
3. You have a right to a replacement ballot. If you make a mistake or want to change your vote, call the County Board of Elections for instructions on how to obtain a new ballot.

4. The number of choices is listed for each contest.
5. Do not mark the ballot for more candidates than allowed. If you do, your vote in that contest will not count.
6. To be counted, absentee ballots returned by mail must be postmarked by the day of the election and be received by the County Board of Elections no later than 7 days after election day.
7. After marking the ballot, fold such envelope bearing the voter's statement.
8. Fill in properly the blanks in the statement.
9. Enclose the sealed envelope bearing the ballot in the outer envelope addressed to the County Board of Elections promptly.
