SCHOOL CROSSING GUARD

<u>DISTINGUISHING FEATURES OF THE CLASS</u>: This is a responsible position calling for the exercise of considerable vigilance in directing traffic for protection of children going to and from school. Work is performed independently with only occasional directions from a supervisor. The incumbent does related work as required.

Assists children crossing street;

Slows traffic in school zone and at crosswalks near schools;

Instructs younger children concerning proper places for crossing the street and precautions that are to be observed.
