1. The Clinton County Treasurer shall have and exercise all the powers and duties conferred or imposed upon him or her by any applicable law.
2. The Clinton County Treasurer receives from local tax Collecting Officers returns which include duplicates of receipts given by such Collecting Officers to the person paying a tax, which receipts include the date of such payment, the name of such person, the description of the property as shown on the tax roll, the name of the person to whom the same is assessed, the amount of such tax and the date of delivery to such officer of the tax roll on account of which such tax was paid. The Clinton County Treasurer also issues receipts for installment tax payments and delinquent tax payments.
3. The State Comptroller has opined that a municipality may charge a reasonable fee for the issuance of duplicate tax receipts.
4. The Clinton County Treasurer is hereby authorized to issue duplicates of receipts received from Collecting Officers, and receipts for installment tax payments and delinquent tax payments issued by the County Treasurer. The duplicates shall constitute proof of payment.

5. The fee for such duplicate tax receipts shall be one (\$1.00) dollar.
6. This Local Law shall take effect upon the filing with the office of the Secretary of State.
