LOCAL LAW NO. 2 OF 1965

COUNTY OF CLINTON, NEW YORK

A LOCAL LAW NO. 2 of the County of Clinton for the year 1965 to provide for legalizing and validating certain claims against the Town of Beekmantown and authorizing payment therefor and authorizing the issuance of obligations for the payment thereof"

BE IT ENACTED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Clinton as follows:

Section 1. A Local Law No. 2 of the Year 1965, of this County entitled, "A LOCAL LAW OF THE COUNTY OF CLINTON FOR THE YEAR 1965 TO PROVIDE FOR LEGALIZING AND VALIDATING CERTAIN CLAIMS AGAINST THE TOWN OF BEEKMANTOWN AND AUTHORIZING PAYMENT THEREFOR AND AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF OBLIGATIONS FOR THE PAYMENT THEREOF".

Section 2. Claims incurred by the Town Superintendent of Highways of the Town of Beekmantown prior to 1964 for Town Highway purposes in the sum of \$36,680.91 pursuant to Subdivision (1) of Section 227 of the County Law incurred, through inadvertance, mistake or error in accounting methods or otherwise, in excess of the total amount appropriated are hereby legalized and validated.

Section 3. The Town of Beekmantown is hereby authorized to pay said claims hereinabove described.

Section 4. The Town of Beekmantown is hereby authorized to issue Serial Bonds for the payment of said claims hereinabove legalized, validated and authorized for payment. Such Serial Bonds shall be issued pursuant to Subdivision 33 of paragraph a of Section 11.00 of the Local Finance Law, and the period of probable usefulness thereof shall be six years, and such Serial Bonds shall be issued not later than July 1, 1965.

Section 5. This Local Law shall take effect immediately.
