Be it enacted	by the Clinton County Legislature of the

Section 1.	Chapter 139 of the Laws of 1996 increases the maximum income ceiling from \$17,800 to \$18,500 for the partial real property tax exemption for property owned by senior citizens 65 and older who meet certain income limitations and other requirements.
Section 2.	This adjustment will also affect the sliding scale option in section 467(1)(b) so that localities choosing the maximum sliding scale option would be permitted to grant some exemption for senior citizens with an income that does not exceed \$26,899.99.

- Section 3. The increase will apply to assessment rolls based on taxable status dates on and after January 1, 1997.
- Section 4. Said increase is necessary to protect our senior citizens on fixed incomes from their ever-increasing local real property tax burden. Such increases are also necessary so that cost of living adjustments in social security do not make currently qualifying senior citizens ineligible for the exemption.
- Section 5. Said local law shall take effect immediately.
