City of Clinton as follows:  Town Village
BE IT ENACTED by the Clinton County Legislature as follows:
SECTION I. Section 922 of the Real Property Tax Law provides the form and content of the statement of taxes to be mailed to each owner of real property.
SECTION II. Given the Medicaid cap legislation enacted in Chapter 58 of the Laws of 2005, the Clinton County Legislature no longer finds that it is necessary to separate the Count tax rates into two parts, one for the general county budget, and the second for unreimbursed Medicaid expenses.
SECTION III. The Clinton County Legislature believes that continued separation of the tax rates of the tax bills will lead to confusion and a misunderstanding of the true increase or decrease of tax rates.
SECTION IV. Local Law #3 of 2002 is hereby repealed.
SECTION V. This local law shall become effective upon filing with the Secretary of State.
