Local Law Filing

BE IT ENACTED by the Legislature of the County of Clinton, State of New York, as follows:

Section 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of any general, special or local law to the contrary, the term of office of the members of the Legislature of Clinton County shall be four (4) years, except for the legislators to be elected in the year 2011, at the general election to be held in November, 2011, at which one half of the said legislative body shall be elected for a two (2) year term commencing in January, 2012 and thereafter shall be elected for four (4) year terms commencing with the general election to be held in November, 2013.

Section 2. For the general election to be held in the year 2011 only, the candidates for the office of members of the Legislature of Clinton County for areas 2, 4, 6, 8, and 10 shall be elected for a two (2) year term. Thereafter legislators elected commencing in the general election to be held in November of 2013 from said areas shall be for a full term of four (4) years.

Section 3. Effective Date. This law shall be submitted for the approval of the electors of the County of Clinton at the next general election to be held on the 3rd day of November, 2009. If this law is approved by the affirmative vote of the majority of the qualified electors of the County voting thereon at such general election, this law shall be effective immediately upon filing with the office of the Secretary of State
