Local Law No. 4 of the year 19 65

A local law "AN ACT AMENDING LOCAL LAW NO. 5 of 1964, AS AMENDED BY LOCAL LAW NO. 3 of 1965, ENTITLED, "AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF PLATTSBURGH AND THE COUNTY OF CLINTON TO ENTER INTO A CO-OPERATIVE AGREEMENT PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION 219-M OF THE GENERAL MUNICIPAL LAW AND PRESCRIBING THE FORM AND TERMS OF SAID AGREEMENT".

Section 1. Paragraph numberd "1" of the agreement set forth in Local Law No. 5 of 1964, as amended by Local Law No. 3 of 1965 is hereby amended to read as follows:

1. There shall be organized by the Contracting parties hereto, a Joint Economic Opportunity Council, which shall consist of twenty-four (24) members, of which the Mayor of the City of Plattsburgh and the Chairman of the Board of Supervisors of Clinton County, shall be ex-officio members and twelve (12) of which members shall be appointed by the Mayor of the City of Plattsburgh and twelve (12) of which shall be appointed by the Chairman of the Clinton County Board of Supervisors. The Chairman of the Council shall be appointed by the Mayor of the City of Plattsburgh and the Chairman of the Board of Supervisors, after selection by the Full Council. The Joint Council will at all times be composed of 40% resident participants and no more than 60% representation from major public and private agencies.

Section 2. This law shall take effect after a public hearing and approval by the Chairman of this Board pursuant to Article 3 of the Municipal Home Rule Law.


