- Section 1. With respect to taxes becoming liens during 1996 and 1997 and in the subsequent years, the redemption period for all "residential property" and "farm property", as those terms are defined in Section 1111 of the Real Property Tax Law, shall be four (4) years after the lien date.
- Section 2. The provisions of Local Law No. 2 of the year 1995 shall remain unchanged except as set forth in this Local Law No. 5 of 1997.
- Section 3. This amendment to Local Law No. 2 of 1995 shall become effective upon filing with the Secretary of State.
