A local law CREATING LEGISLATIVE DISTRICTS FOR THE COUNTY OF CLINTON  
(Insert title)

Be it enacted by the COUNTY LEGISLATURE of the  
(Name of Legislative Body)

SECTION 1. Number of Legislators.

The Legislature shall consist of ten (10) members, chosen from the districts described within and apportioned among the County on the basis of the number of inhabitants of the County of Clinton in the year 1980 as set forth in this Law.

SECTION 2. Legislative Districts.

There shall be ten (10) legislative districts apportioned among the County, which are described hereafter.

SECTION 3. Construction:

- A. This Law shall be liberally construed to effectuate the purposes thereof and to apportion and district the County of Clinton in compliance with the requirements of law.
- B. It is intended that this Law and the districts described herein completely encompass all the area within the County of Clinton. It is also intended that such districts, apportioned on the basis of the 1980 population, shall be...

out the purposes thereof because of unintentional omission; duplications, overlapping areas; erroneous nomenclature; lack of adequate maps or descriptions of political subdivisions, wards or other divisions thereof, or of their boundary lines; street closings; changes of names of streets, or other changes of public places; alteration of the boundary or courses of the waterways; filling in of lands underwater, accretion or other changes in shorelines; or alteration of courses, rights of way, or lines of public utilities or other conditions, then the Clinton County Board of Elections, at the request of any person aggrieved thereby or any candidate affected thereby, shall, by order, correct such omissions, overlaps, erroneous nomenclature, or other defects in description of districts so as to accomplish the purposes and objectives of this Law.

SECTION 5. Description of Legislative Districts.

- A. LEGISLATIVE DISTRICT #1 shall consist of the following: The Town of Champlain and that portion of the Town of Mooers consisting of Mooers Election Districts #1 and #2.
- B. LEGISLATIVE DISTRICT #2 shall consist of the following: That portion of the Town of Mooers consisting of Mooers Election District #3, the Town of Clinton, the Town of Altona, the Town of Dannemora and the Town of Ellenburg.
- C. LEGISLATIVE DISTRICT #3 shall consist of the following: The Town of Chazy and the Town of Beekmantown.
- D. LEGISLATIVE DISTRICT #4 shall consist of the following: That portion of the Town of Plattsburgh consisting of Election Districts #1, #2, #4 and #6 and that portion of Election District #5 more particularly described as follows: Beginning at a point where the west bounds of the City of Plattsburgh municipal line intersects with the center line of Rugar Street; thence running in a westerly direction along the center line of Rugar Street to a point where said center line intersects with the center line of the Old Military Turnpike Extension; thence turning and running in a northwesterly direction along the center line of said Military Turnpike Extension to a point where said center line intersects with the center line of New York State Route #3; thence turning and running in an easterly direction along the center line of New York State Route #3 to a point where said center line intersects with the westerly bounds of the City of Plattsburgh municipal limits; thence turning and running in a southerly direction along the westerly bounds of said municipal limits to the point or place of beginning.
- E. LEGISLATIVE DISTRICT #5 shall consist of the

#1884; thence turning and running in a westerly direction so as to include Buildings numbers 1884, 1882 and 1880; thence continuing to a point in the west bounds of said Plattsburgh Air Force Base; thence turning and running in a northerly direction along the westerly bounds of said Plattsburgh Air Force Base to a point which marks the northeasterly corner of the Town of Plattsburgh Election District #3; thence continuing along the westerly and northerly bounds of Plattsburgh Air Force Base as it winds and turns to the point or place of beginning; hereby intending to include specifically the residents of said area and of the nine buildings easterly of Idaho Avenue bearing numbers 1904, 1906, 1908, 1940, 1942, 1944, 1880, 1882 and 1884 on said Plattsburgh Air Force Base; and that portion of the Town of Schuyler Falls consisting of Election District #3.

- F. LEGISLATIVE DISTRICT #6 shall consist of the following: The Town of Saranac, the Town of Black Brook and that portion of the Town of Schuyler Falls consisting of Election Districts numbers 1 and 2.
- G. LEGISLATIVE DISTRICT #7 shall consist of the following: The Town of Peru and the Town of AuSable.
- H. LEGISLATIVE DISTRICT #8 shall consist of the following: That portion of the City of Plattsburgh consisting of Ward I, Districts 1, 2, 3 and 4; that portion of the Town of Plattsburgh described as follows: Beginning at a point where the center line of Rugar Street intersects with the westerly bounds of the City of Plattsburgh municipal limits; thence turning and running in a westerly direction along the center line of Rugar Street to a point where said center line intersects with the center line of the Old Military Turnpike Extension; thence turning and running in a north-westerly direction along the center line of the Old Military Turnpike Extension to a point where said center line intersects with the center line of New York State Route #3; thence turning and running in a southwesterly direction and across the property known as the Clinton County Airport to a point located in the center of the Saranac River; thence turning and running along the center of the Saranac River as it winds and turns to a point where said center of the Saranac River meets the northeast corner of the Town of Plattsburgh Election District #3; thence running along the northerly bounds of said Election District #3 to the northwest corner of said district bounds; thence turning and running in a southerly direction along the westerly bounds of Election District #3 to a point where said northerly bounds of Election District #3 intersects with th e

a point where said center line would intersect with the northerly bounds of said Plattsburgh Air Force Base; thence running in a southerly direction to a point south of New York Road and just easterly of Building #1884; thence turning and running in a westerly direction so as to include Buildings numbers 1884, 1882 and 1880, and continuing on to a point in the west bounds of said Plattsburgh Air Force Base; thence turning and running in a northerly direction along the westerly bounds of said Plattsburgh Air Force Base to a point which marks the northeasterly corner of the Town of Plattsburgh Election District #3; thence continuing along the westerly and northerly bounds of Plattsburgh Air Force Base as it winds and turns to the point or place of beginning; hereby intending to include specifically the residents of said area and of the nine buildings easterly of Idaho Avenue bearing numbers 1904, 1906, 1908, 1940, 1942, 1944, 1880, 1882 and 1884 on said Plattsburgh Air Force Base.

- I. LEGISLATIVE DISTRICT #9 shall consist of the following: That portion of the City of Plattsburgh which consists of Ward II, Election Districts numbers 1, 2, 3, 5 and 6.
- J. LEGISLATIVE DISTRICT #10 shall consist of the following: That portion of the City of Plattsburgh consisting of Ward III, Election Districts numbers 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 and 6 and that portion of Ward II consisting of Election District #4.

SECTION 6. Permissive Referendum.

This Law shall be subject to permissive referendum pursuant to Section 24 of the Municipal Home Rule Law and Section 101 of the County Law and shall take effect immediately as provided by said sections.

SECTION 7. Maps of the Districts.

Attached hereto and marked as Schedules A and B are copies of maps showing the general configuration of the districts described in this Local Law and which are intended to aid in showing the configurations of said districts, but are intended not to control said configurations.

SECTION 8. Mathematical Distribution.

Attached hereto and marked as Schedule C is the mathematical distribution as to the legislative districts described herein.

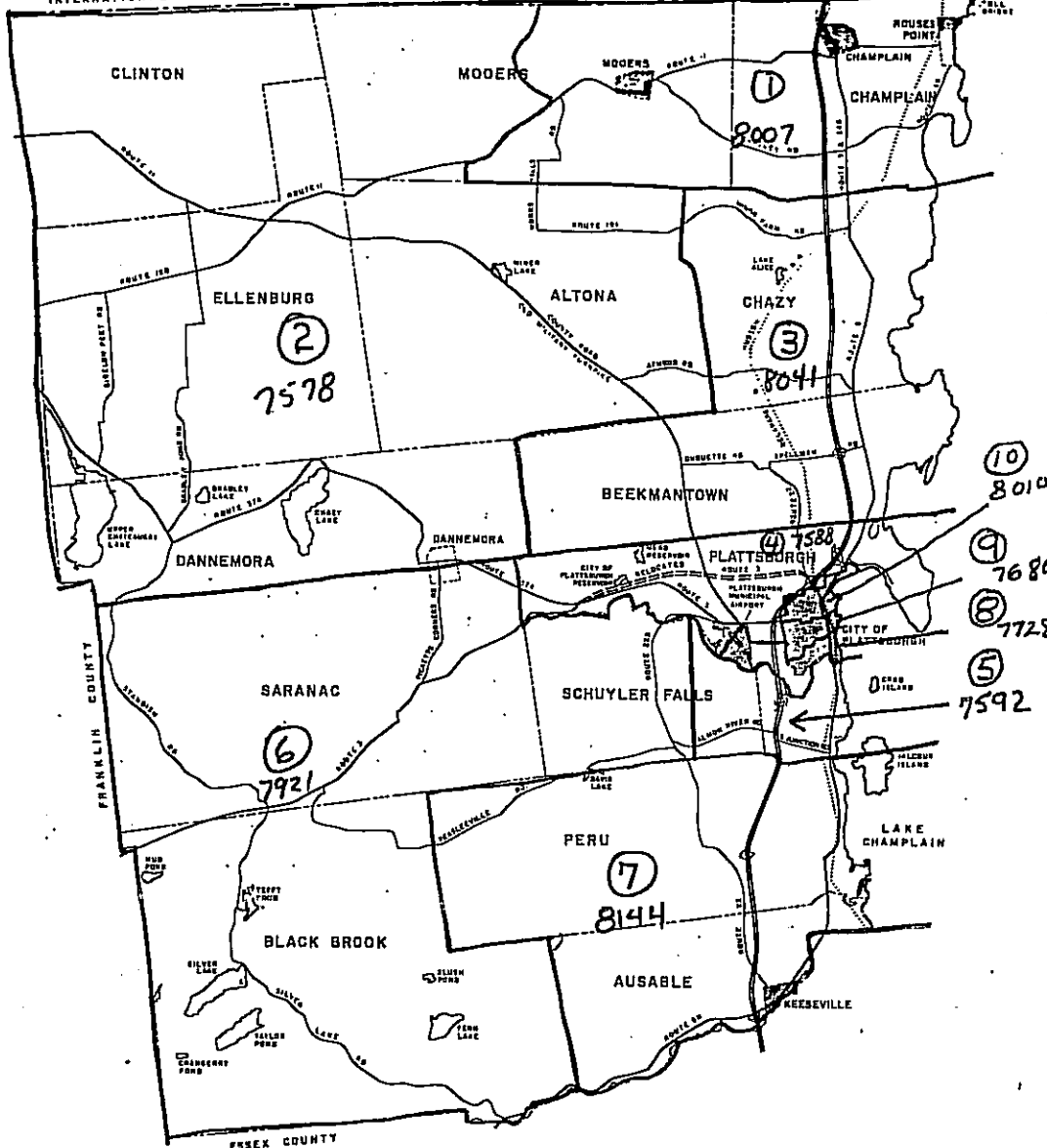
