A local law which would amend Local Law #5 of 1997 titled, "Amending Local Law #2 of 1995 to Permanently Extend the Redemption Period for Residential Property and Farm Property from Two to Four Years"

- Section 1. With respect to taxes becoming liens in 2007, the redemption period for all residential and farm property shall be three (3) years after the lien date.
- Section 2. With respect to taxes becoming liens in 2008 and in subsequent years, the redemption period for residential and farm property shall be two (2) years after the lien date.
- Section 3. The provisions of Local Law No. 5 of the year 1997 shall remain unchanged except as set forth in this Local Law #1 of 2006.
- Section 4. This amendment to Local Law No. 5 of 1997 shall become effective upon filing with the Secretary of State.




