Local Law No. 2 of the year 19 82

A local law AUTHORIZING THE CLINTON COUNTY LEGISLATURE TO ENTER INTO A
JOINT AGREEMENT WITH OTHER COUNTIES SIMILARLY SITUATED TO
OPERATE A CONSORTIUM FOR THE JOB TRAINING PARTNERSHIP ACT

Be it enacted by the County Legislature of the

- Section 1. Purpose: The Federal Government has passed new legislation for the Job Training Partnership Act that attempts to eliminate the various levels of municipal authority and reduce contracts. Said legislation requires there be a minimum population of 200,000 in a single governmental unit, or a combination of units of contiguous governments totalling 200,000 persons or more, or a definite labor market area less than 200,000 persons if recognized by the Governor. This Local Law is enabling legislation to allow an agreement between various North Country counties.
- Section 2. Franklin County may by resolution enter into an agreement with other counties in Northern New York to form a Consortium Agency to act as a conduit through which federal state, local and private funding may be received and disbursed to member counties under the general guidelines of the Federal Government Job Training Program and State enabling legislation (if any). Said Consortium shall generally be governed by a Board consisting of representatives of the respective counties and shall have an Executive Director (Administrator) and staff. The primary function of said agency shall be to receive and distribute funding aforesaid. The agreement between the counties may provide for other functions for said agency related to the Job Training Partnership Act duties and obligations.
- Section 3. This Local Law shall become effective immediately as provided by the Municipal Home Rule Law. Any resolutions or agreements made prior to this Local Law being adopted relating to the operation of a Consortium under this program shall be authorized by this Local Law. No agreement to set up and operate this Consortium entity shall be effective until authorized by the Clinton County Board of Legislators.

The foregoing was moved by Mr. Paquette and seconded by Mr. Garrow. Adopted by roll call vote of 8 "Yes", 1 "No", 1 Absent.
