A local law "AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF PLATTSBURGH AND THE COUNTY OF CLINTON TO ENTER INTO A CO-OPERATIVE AGREEMENT PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION 119-M OF THE GENERAL MUNICIPAL LAW AND PRESCRIBING THE FORM AND TERMS OF SAID AGREEMENT"

Section 1. Paragraph numbered "1" of the Agreement set forth in Local Law No. 4 of 1964 is hereby amended to read as follows:

"There shall be organized by the contracting parties hereto, a joint Economic Opportunity Council, which shall consist of such number of members as shall be jointly determined by the Mayor of the City of Plattsburgh and the Chairman of the Board of Supervisors. One-half of the members of such council shall be appointed by the Mayor of the City of Plattsburgh and one-half of the members of such council shall be appointed by the Chairman of the Board of Supervisors. The Mayor of the City of Plattsburgh and the Chairman of the Board of Supervisors shall be ex-officio members of such Council. The Chairman of the Council shall be appointed by the Mayor of the City of Plattsburgh and the Chairman of the Board of Supervisors after selection by the full council.

Section 2. This Local Law shall take effect immediately.




