BE IT ENACTED BY the Clinton County Legislature as follows:

Section 1. Section 922 of the Real Property Tax Law provides the form and content of the statement of taxes to be mailed to each owner of real property.

Section 2. The Clinton County Legislature desires to show the true costs of county government for Medicaid expenses, which are mandated by the State of New York, yet not reimbursed by the State of New York.

Section 3. County tax rates shall be separated into two parts, one for the general county budget, and the second for unreimbursed Medicaid expenses.

Section 4. This local law shall take effect upon filing in the Office of the Secretary of State as provided by Section 27 of the Municipal Home Rule Law.
