Section 1. Pursuant to Section 381 of the Executive Law of the State of New York, the County of Clinton hereby Elects Not to Enforce the Uniform Fire Prevention Code of the State of New York as provided in said section.

Section 2. Effective date of this Local Law shall be due date prescribed by Section 381 of the Executive Law of the State of New York.
