NARRATIVE: On the above date and time, Clinton County Sheriff's Deputies arrested Justin D. Herzog on the abovelisted charges following a reported domestic incident that occurred at a residence in the Town of Chazy. Investigation at the scene revealed Herzog allegedly strangled and assaulted a female victim, resulting in physical injury to the victim. It's also alleged that Herzog menaced the female victim and a male juvenile victim with a knife during the incident and struggled with the female victim for possession of the knife. Herzog also allegedly caused multiple instances of property damage in the residence and prevented the victims for calling for emergency assistance.

DISPOSITION: Herzog was transported from the scene to the Sheriff's Office for processing, following which he was arraigned in Chazy Town Court on all charges. Following arraignment, Herzog was committed to Clinton County Correctional Facility in lieu of \$25,000 cash bail, \$50,000 secured bond. Orders of Protection were issued for the victims. Herzog is set to reappear in Chazy Town Court on a later date. The female victim was transported from the scene by Chazy Fire Department EMS to UVM CVPH Medical Center for treatment of her injuries and later released.
