NARRATIVE: On February 28, 2016, Sheriff's Deputies received information shortly before midnight from Officers with US Customs and Border Protection at the Champlain Port of Entry that Lisette Nevelus, who had recently entered the country at that location, was potentially going to be traveling to a residence in the Town of Plattsburgh from which she was required to stay away from per an active Order of Protection. Sheriff's Deputies patrolled to the residence and located Nevelus inside, along with several individuals who were also named as protected parties in the same Order.

DISPOSITION: Nevelus was arrested and charged with a single count of criminal contempt in the second degree. She was arraigned in Town of Beekmantown Court and committed to Clinton County Correctional Facility in lieu of \$500 cash bail, \$1000 secured bond. She is set to appear in Town of Plattsburgh Court on a later date.
