NARRATIVE: On the above date, Sheriff's Deputies responded to a residence on Town Line Road in the Town of Plattsburgh for a reported motor vehicle accident and individuals fighting in the driveway. The above listed individuals were arrested on the above charges following an investigation by the responding deputies. It's alleged that Mark Stone went to the residence to retrieve property at which time he was physically attacked by Scott Vincent. Stone then allegedly operated his motor vehicle in a reckless manner on the property and intentionally attempted to strike Vincent with the vehicle. Vincent and Aaron Mullen allegedly intentionally caused damage to Stone's vehicle and it's also alleged that Vincent assaulted Stone resulting in physical injury.

DISPOSITION: Vincent and Mullen were transported from the scene to the Sheriff's Office for processing, after which Mullen was released on an appearance ticket. Vincent was arraigned in Town of Peru Court and released on his own recognizance. Vincent was evaluated at the scene by EMS and signed off on medical treatment. Stone was transported from the scene to UVM CVPH Medical Center with multiple facial injuries. Upon release from the hospital, Stone was processed at the Sheriff's Office and released on an appearance ticket. All parties are set to appear in Town of Plattsburgh Court on a later date. Deputies were assisted on scene by Morrisonville EMS and Morrisonville Fire Department.
