**NARRATIVE:** On the above date and time, Sheriff's Deputies arrested James Potter at the Champlain Point Port of Entry following a complaint received by Deputies from officers with Customs and Border Protection. It's alleged that Potter was found to be unlawfully in possession of a two handguns and large capacity ammunition feeding devices upon entry in the United States.

**DISPOSITION:** Potter was processed at the Sheriff's Office and arraigned in Chazy Town Court, after which he was committed to Clinton County Correctional Facility in lieu of \$2,500 cash bail, \$5,000 secured bond. He is set to appear in Town of Champlain court on a later date. Deputies were assisted in the investigation by Customs and Border Protection and Homeland Security Investigations.
