NARRATIVE: On the above date and time, Clinton County Sheriff's Deputies responded to the O'Neil Road in the Town of Beekmantown for a report of a car versus pedestrian motor vehicle accident. Preliminary investigation shows that Brandon Burl was operating a 2007 Dodge Durango north on O'Neil Road when he struck Robert Seymour, who entered the roadway from the western shoulder of the road.

DISPOSITION: Seymour was transported to UVM-CVPH Medical Center and later transferred to the University of Vermont Medical Center for treatment of a head injury and fractures to both wrists and ankles. Seymour is reported to be in critical condition. Burl was not injured in the motor vehicle accident. Deputies were assisted on scene by Beekmantown Fire Department and UVM-CVPH EMS. Investigation into the motor vehicle accident is still on going and no tickets have been issued at this time.
