NARRATIVE: Sheriff Deputies were dispatched at 7:15pm to the intersection of State Route 374 and the Narrows Rd. for a reported personal injury motor vehicle accident. Upon arrival at the scene, Brock A. LeClair and Thomas H. Bouvia Jr. had been transported to UVM-CVPH Medical Center by Lyon Mountain EMS and Ellenburg Center EMS respectively. The preliminary investigation has determined that a 2014 Suzuki 750 AXI Kingquad was being operated in a northwesterly direction on the Narrows Rd. when it exited the northeast shoulder of the road, just north of the intersection of the Gadway Rd. Upon exiting the roadway the ATV struck multiple trees and the two helmeted male occupants were ejected from the ATV. A short time later a passer-by located the wreckage and contacted 911.

DISPOSITION: At the time of this release, both males have been transported to Fletcher-Allen Health Care where they are being treated for their injuries. LeClair has suffered head injuries, internal injuries as well as multiple fractures. Bouvia has suffered head injuries as well as internal injuries. Both are listed in critical condition. The NYSP Collision Reconstruction Unit was called to the scene and are assisting the sheriff's office in the investigation. Assistance was also received from the NYSP Plattsburgh, NYS Forest Rangers, Lyon Mountain EMS and Fire, Ellenburg Center EMS, Dannemora EMS, Saranac EMS and Morrisonville EMS.
