CHARGES: VTL 1129A Following too closely (Viol)

DATE AND TIME OF INCIDENT: 12/04/2013 1723Hrs

NARRATIVE: On the date listed above Sheriff's Deputies were dispatched to the intersection of NYS RTE 374 and NYS RTE 22 in the Town of Plattsburgh for a four car motor vehicle accident with injuries. Sheriff's Patrols, New York State Police, New York State ENCON Police, District 3 Fire Department and CVPH EMS also responded. Sheriff's Deputies interviewed witnesses that stated, Linwood J Latney was operating a 2004 KIA west on NYS RTE 22 towards NYS RTE 374 when he allegedly struck the rear end of a 2002 Dodge operated by Amy Dubrey-Wilson. The force of this collision then caused Dubrey-Wilson to strike the rear end of a 2009 Subaru operated by June Dufrane. The force of this third collision caused Dufrane to then strike the rear of a 2013 Ford operated by Stephen Connors.

DISPOSITION: Most parties involved including a passenger in the first vehicle, Derek Fagan of Plattsburgh, were transported to CVPH and their conditions are unknown. Stephen Connors was not transported. The operator of the vehicle that allegedly caused the accident, Linwood Latney, was issued a UTT for following too closely. Latney has a court date of 12/19/2013 In the Town of Plattsburgh at 1800hrs. The exact cause of the accident is still under investigation.
