A driver who ran a red light during evening rush-hour caused a two-car motor vehicle accident Friday May 7, 2010 that sent a local woman to the hospital.

Deputies from the Clinton County Sheriff's Office responded to a to a motor vehicle accident just after 5:00p.m. at the intersection of Route 22 and Route 374.

According to witnesses, a vehicle driven by Gloria Bobby of Plattsburgh failed to stop for a red light and continued west bound on Route 374 before striking a vehicle driven by Laura Fountain of West Chazy.

Bobbie, who sustained reported minor injuries, was transported to CVPH medical center for treatment.

The Clinton County Sheriff's Office is continuing its investigation into the accident and tickets are pending.
