On Wednesday January 6, 2010 the Clinton County Sheriff's Department arrested an out-of-state woman – charging her with aggravated unlicensed operation of a motor vehicle and several other offenses.

Sheriff's deputies on routine patrol – arrested 28-year-old Jennifer Blair of Alburg Vermont on Route 9B in Champlain. Deputies observed Blair driving with an expired inspection sticker and subsequently pulled her over. Blair admitted to Deputies she was driving with a suspended license. Deputies also discovered Blair had pending tickets for expired inspection, suspended registration and insurance not in effect.

Blair was taken into custody and charged with 1 count of misdemeanor aggravated unlicensed operation of a motor vehicle and 1 count of misdemeanor driving with a suspended registration.

She was also charged with 2 violations – driving without a valid inspection sticker and operating a motor vehicle with no insurance coverage.

Blair was arraigned in Champlain Town Court and released on her own recognizance. She will reappear in Champlain Town Court on January 14th, 2010 to face the allegations.
