On Friday December 11, 2009 a local man wanted on an outstanding county court warrant - walked into the Clinton County Sheriffs Department and turned himself in.

19-year-old Joshua P. Bombardier of West Chazy was taken into custody by Sheriffs Deputies at around4:45P.M.

Bombardier was indicted in October on several charges that occurred on or about February 8, 2009 including:

Aggravated vehicular homicide 2nd degree vehicular manslaughter Manslaughter in the 2nd degree Criminally negligent homicide 2nd degree vehicular homicide Assault in the 3rd degree Reckless endangerment in the 2nd degree Operating a vehicle under the influence of alcohol and reckless driving.

At 5:00 P.M. Bombardier was still being processed at the Clinton County Sheriff's Department – no word on when he will be arraigned or if bail will be set.
