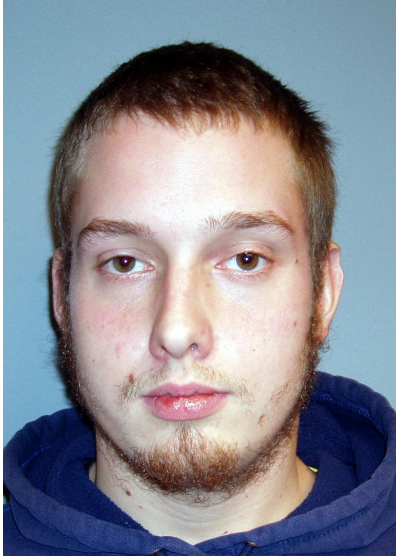

## **FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE**

On Friday December 11, 2009 a local man wanted on an outstanding county court warrant - walked into the Clinton County Sheriffs Department and turned himself in.

19-year-old Joshua P. Bombardier of West Chazy was taken into custody by Sheriffs Deputies at around 4:45 P.M.

Bombardier was indicted in October on several charges that occurred on or about February 8, 2009 including:

- Aggravated vehicular homicide
- 2<sup>nd</sup> degree vehicular manslaughter
- Manslaughter in the 2<sup>nd</sup> degree
- Criminally negligent homicide
- 2<sup>nd</sup> degree vehicular homicide
- Assault in the 3<sup>rd</sup> degree
- Reckless endangerment in the 2<sup>nd</sup> degree

Operating a vehicle under the influence of alcohol and reckless driving.

At 5:00 P.M. Bombardier was still being processed at the Clinton County Sheriff's Department – no word on when he will be arraigned or if bail will be set.
