Two women who attempted to smuggle several pounds of marijuana through the Champlain border crossing into the United States are behind bars facing felony drug charges.

Deputies arrested 21-year-old Julianna Wolf of the Bronx and 21-year-old Kimberly Roman of Manhattan at the Champlain border crossing at around 3:00a.m. this morning.

Customs and Border Protection agents Discovered 21.7 pounds of marijuana under a suit case in the trunk of the car the two were driving.

The marijuana has an estimated street value of between \$22,000 and \$66,000.

Wolf and Roman were taken into custody by sheriff's deputies and each charged with 1<sup>st</sup> degree criminal possession of marijuana – a class "C" felony.

The two were arraigned in Plattsburgh Town Court and sent to the Clinton County Jail on \$10,000 cash bail. Wolf and Roman will re-appear in Plattsburgh Town Court on July 29, 2010 to face the charges.
