

PRESS RELEASE FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE

On Sunday February 28, 2010 the Clinton County Sheriff's Office arrested a local man on numerous charges including unlicensed operation of a motor vehicle and DWI.

50-year-old Timothy Call of Plattsburgh was stopped by Sheriff's deputies on route 22 in the Town of Plattsburgh around 8:30p.m. – after deputies noticed Call driving without his headlights on.

Call failed field sobriety tests administered by deputies. He was taken to CVPH Medical Center and submitted to a blood test to determine his blood alcohol level.

Call was taken to the Clinton County Sheriff's Office for processing where he was charged with one felony count of aggravated unlicensed operation of a motor vehicle, one misdemeanor count of DWI and several infractions including: drinking alcohol in a motor vehicle on the highway, operating an unregistered motor vehicle and driving with inadequate lights.

Call was placed on pre-trial release and is scheduled to appear in Plattsburgh Town Court on March 4, 2010 to face the allegations.
