

Juan Pablo Camacho, a triple-murder suspect, being held at the Clinton County jail was extradited back to California today.

Under tight security, Officials from the Long Beach City Police Department escorted the 33-year-old violent felony offender to a waiting airplane around 9:30a.m. Camacho is wanted by authorities in Long Beach for questioning as a suspect in at least three murders in the California area.

Camacho, who was released from the federal prison in Ray Brook earlier this month, was being held at the Clinton County Jail on a fugitive from justice warrant until his extradition could be finalized.

Camacho, who is believed to have gang affiliation, is expected to face additional felony charges upon his return to California.
