On Monday July 26, 2010 a Morrisonville New York man who came to the Clinton County Jail to inquire about a bail he had posted for another individual ended up being arrested moments later and is now facing charges for DWAI.

Deputies from the Clinton County Sheriff's Office arrested 52-year-old Ernest Cayea just before 4:00 p.m. near Trade Road and Route 22.

Cayea was stopped by deputies after they observed him run a stop sign. During the stop deputies observed Cayea in what appeared to be an intoxicated state.

He was taken to the Clinton County Sheriff's Office for processing where he submitted to a breath test which showed him to be legally impaired.

Deputies charged Cayea with DWAI and failing to stop at a stop sign. He was released to a third party and will appear in Plattsburgh Town Court at a later date to face the charges.
