A Westport New York man is facing felony charges after deputies say he allegedly drove drunk with an open container of alcohol in his vehicle early Sunday morning.

33-year-old Tommy Conley was stopped by deputies from the Clinton County Sheriff's Office around 1:00a.m. on Route 22B in the Town of Plattsburgh after they observed him driving erratically.

Conley failed field sobriety tests administered by deputies. He was taken into custody and brought to the Clinton County Sheriff's Office for processing. Conley submitted to a breath test which showed his blood alcohol level to be more than two times the legal limit.

Conley, who had a previous conviction for DWI in 2001, was charged with felony aggravated DWI. Deputies also charged Conley with drinking alcohol in a motor vehicle and failure to use a designated lane.

Conley was arraigned in Plattsburgh Town Court and sent to the Clinton County Jail on \$750 cash bail, which he later posted. He will reappear in Plattsburgh Town Court at a later date to face the charges.
