On Sunday February 28, 2010 the Clinton County Sheriff's Office arrested a Plattsburgh woman and charged her with misdemeanor DWI.

20-year-old Kari Connelly of Plattsburgh was stopped by sheriff's deputies around 3:30 a.m. Sunday on route 374 in the town of Plattsburgh. Deputies observed Connelly driving erratically and subsequently pulled her over.

Connelly failed field sobriety tests administered by deputies. She was subsequently given a breath test which revealed her blood alcohol level to be twice the legal limit.

Connelly was taken into custody and brought to the Clinton County Sheriff's office for processing. In addition to the misdemeanor DWI charge -Connelly was also charged with two other offenses – failure to keep right and crossing a hazard line.

She was released on her own recognizance and is scheduled to appear in Plattsburgh Town Court on March 4, 2010 to face the allegations.
