On Sunday February 7, 2010 the Clinton County Sheriff's Office arrested a Plattsburgh man and charged him with felony DWI.

33-year-old Matthew Dewey of Plattsburgh was stopped by sheriff's deputies around 11:00 p.m. on route 374 in the town of Plattsburgh for failure to use a turn signal.

During the stop deputies observed Dewey in what appeared to be an intoxicated state. Dewey failed field sobriety tests administered by deputies. He was subsequently given a breath test which revealed his blood alcohol level to be three-times the legal limit.

Dewey was taken into custody and brought to the Clinton County Sheriff's office. He was charged with felony aggravated DWI. Dewey had a previous DWI conviction in 2003.

He was arraigned in Plattsburgh Town Court and sent to the Clinton County Jail on \$500 cash bail.
