On Friday April 23, 2010 the Clinton County Sheriff's Office charged a local man with DWI.

59-year-old Bradley Dow of Altona was arrested just before 7:30p.m. while driving on Route 3 in the Town of Plattsburgh.

Deputies pulled Dow over after they observed him driving erratically.

Dow failed field sobriety tests administered by deputies. Dow was taken to the Clinton County Sheriff's Office for processing. Dow submitted to a breath test which showed him to be legally intoxicated.

Deputies charged Dow with one count of misdemeanor DWI. He was also ticketed for failing to signal a lane change.

Dow was released to the custody of a third party and will appear in Plattsburgh Town Court on April 29, 2010 to face the allegations.
