A joint effort between the Clinton County Sheriff's Office and Plattsburgh Police Department led to the capture of a violent sex offender living in the Plattsburgh area from Tennessee who failed to properly register his new address.

Acting on a tip, deputies from the Clinton County Sheriff's Office along with officers from the Plattsburgh Police Department arrested 48-year-old Matthew Gibson of Tennessee at the Super 8 Motel at around 6:00p.m. on November 30, 2010.

Gibson, who is considered a violent sex offender, was convicted of kidnapping and rape more than two decades ago. Gibson last updated his address with Tennessee authorities in June of 2010 and left the state sometime after that and was recently found living in the Plattsburgh area. Deputies charged Gibson with Felony failure to register as a sex offender. He was arraigned in Plattsburgh Town Court and sent to the Clinton County Jail on \$10,000 cash bail. Gibson is due back in Plattsburgh Town Court at a later date to face the charges.
