An out-of-state man is facing charges for allegedly driving without a license.

Deputies from the Clinton County Sheriff's Office arrested 29year-old Jeremy Rector of Essex Junction Vermont around 11:30p.m. on Thursday December 30, 2010.

Deputies stopped Rector after they observed him speeding in excess of the posted speed limit. During the stop deputies discovered Rector's privilege to drive in the state of New York was suspended.

Rector was taken to the Clinton County Sheriff's Officer for processing. Deputies charged him with misdemeanor aggravated unlicensed operation of a motor vehicle and ticketed him for speeding.

Rector was arraigned in Plattsburgh Town Court and sent to the Clinton County Jail on \$200 cash bail, which he later posted. Rector will reappear in Plattsburgh Town Court at a later date to face the charges.
