On Thursday June 24, 2010 the Clinton County Sheriff's Office charged an out-of-state man with DWI.

61-year-old Robert Roy of Lowell Massachusetts was arrested on State Route 3 in the Town of Plattsburgh just before 1:00a.m. Deputies pulled Roy over after they witnessed him driving erratically.

Roy failed field sobriety tests administered by deputies. He was taken to the Clinton County Sheriff's Office for processing. Roy submitted to a breath test which showed him to be legally intoxicated.

Deputies charged Roy with misdemeanor DWI, harassment and several other offenses related to vehicle and traffic law.

Roy was arraigned in Plattsburgh Town Court and sent to the Clinton County Jail on \$750 cash bail which he later posted. Roy is due back in Plattsburgh Town Court at a later date to face the charges.
