A Plattsburgh man stopped by Sheriff's deputies early Friday morning for speeding is now facing multiple felony charges for DWI and driving without a license.

26-year-old Charles Snay was arrested by deputies from the Clinton County Sheriff's Office shortly after 1:30a.m. on Margaret Street. Deputies pulled Snay over after they observed him speeding and discovered he was intoxicated.

Snay failed field sobriety tests administered by deputies. He was taken to the Clinton County Sheriff's Office for processing. Snay submitted to a breath test which showed him to be legally intoxicated.

Snay was charged with one count of felony DWI because of a previous DWI conviction in 2008, one felony count of aggravated unlicensed operation of a motor vehicle. He was also charged with three other offenses: Speeding, failure to notify DMV of and address change and inadequate license plate lights.

Snay was arraigned in Plattsburgh City Court and sent to the Clinton County jail on \$2000 cash bail or \$4000 bond. He will reappear in Plattsburgh City Court at a later date to face the charges.
