A Cadyville New York man who crashed his car near Rand Hill Road late Saturday night faces charges for DWI.

Just before midnight on Saturday April 10, 2010 Deputies from the Clinton County Sheriff's Office responded to a call from Beekmantown Fire Department about a one-car motor vehicle accident at the intersection of Ninety Nine and Rand Hill Road

Deputies who arrived on the scene discovered the car driven by 44-year-old Steven Shook off the road and tipped over on its passenger side against a large cedar tree. Deputies observed Shook conscious and sitting on the ground near his vehicle.

Shook was apparently traveling south bound on Rand Hill Road when he failed to negotiate a curve and went airborne before his vehicle went off the side of the road and flipped on its passenger side.

Shook was unable to complete all the field sobriety tests usually administered by deputies. He was transported to CVPH medical center for evaluation. While at the hospital blood was drawn to determine his blood alcohol level.

Shook was treated and released into the custody of deputies who transported him to the Clinton County Sheriff's Office for processing.

Deputies charged Shook with one misdemeanor count of DWI. He was ticked and released to a third party. He will appear in court at a later date to face the allegations.

Additional charges are possible pending laboratory results.
