A local woman who had to be transported to the hospital after driving her car off the road is now facing charges for driving under the influence of drugs.

Deputies responded to a one-car accident at around 6:00p.m. on Saturday May 22, 2010 on State Route 3 near Wallabee road in the Town of Saranac.

Upon arriving at the scene deputies discovered that 40-yearold Monica Gillette of Standish had driven her car off the road. She was transported to CVPH medical center where she was treated for minor injuries.

Gillette was released into the custody of deputies who charged her with misdemeanor DWAI-Drugs and unsafe lane change.

Gillette is due to appear in Saranac Town Court on May 31, 2010 to face the charges.
