A Peru New York woman is facing multiple felony charges after she allegedly tried to pass drugs to an inmate during a visit at the Clinton County Jail on Sunday July 18, 2010.

21-year-old Heather Parker was arrested by Sheriff's deputies at the Clinton County Jail after staff reported seeing her trying to pass something to an inmate. Deputies recovered what appeared to be two different controlled substances.

Parker was taken to the Clinton County Sheriff's Office where she was charged with criminal sale of a controlled substance in the 4th degree a class "C" felony, criminal sale of a controlled substance in the 5th degree a class "D" felony and introducing dangerous contraband into a prison in the 1st degree a class "D" felony.

Parker was arraigned in Plattsburgh Town Court and sent to the Clinton County Jail on \$2500 cash bail. She is scheduled to reappear in Plattsburgh Town Court on July 20, 2010 to face the charges.

The drugs deputies recovered during the arrest will be sent to the New York State Crime Lab for analysis and additional charges may be pending.
