## **FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE**

On Tuesday January 26, 2010 Sheriffs deputies arrested a Plattsburgh man and charged him with possession of a forged instrument.

Following a short-term investigation by the Clinton County Sheriffs department - 34-year-old Jacob Schneider of Plattsburgh was arrested at his Bailey Avenue residence at around 7:45p.m. - last night. He is charged with one class D felony count of possessing a forged instrument – for having a 10-day temporary vehicle inspection sticker with an altered expiration date.

Deputies first became aware of the altered inspection sticker January 15, 2010- during a routine traffic stop on Tom Miller road.

During that traffic stop deputies seized the inspection sticker pending further investigation. A check of DMV records showed the stickers expiration date had been changed from 11/25/09 to 12/28/09.

Schneider was arraigned in Plattsburgh Town Court and placed on pre-trial release. If convicted - Schneider could face up-to seven years in prison.
