**NARRATIVE**: On the above date, at about 9:04pm, Sheriff's Deputies responded to a reported motor vehicle collision on Interstate 87 in the Town of Beekmantown. Investigation determined that Christopher Willette was operating a 2008 Ford Fusion north on Interstate 87 when he struck a guide rail off the western shoulder of the roadway.
