**NARRATIVE:** On the above date and time, Clinton County Sheriff's Deputies arrested Noah R. Borden on the above-listed charges following a traffic stop in the Town of Plattsburgh. It's alleged that Borden was operating a motor vehicle while in an intoxicated condition. It's also alleged that Borden was found to be in possession of an amount of a controlled substance at the time of the traffic stop.
