NARRATIVE: On the above date and time, Clinton County Sheriff's Deputies arrested Chelsea E. Currier, of Cadyville, following the report of a property damage accident on State Route 22 in the Town of Beekmantown. Upon investigation by deputies on the scene, Currier was traveling southbound on State Route 22 when she crossed a double solid line and subsequently struck a street sign before the vehicle came to rest. Further investigation alleges that Currier was operating in an impaired condition. The Sheriff's Office was assisted by the New York State Police, Beekmantown Fire Department, District 3 Fire Department and CVPH EMS.

DISPOSITION: Currier was transported to CVPH for medical evaluation and later released. She was then transported to the Clinton County Sheriff's Office for processing, ticketed and released. She is set to reappear in the Beekmantown Town Court at a later date to face the allegations.
