SUBJECT OF RELEASE: Fatal Motor Vehicle Collision

NARRATIVE: The Clinton County Sheriff's Office is investigating a motor vehicle collision that resulted in the death of an operator of one of the vehicles involved. The collision occurred at the intersection of the Golf Course Rd and Dry Bridge Rd in the Town of Black Brook.

The preliminary investigation revealed a 79 year old female was operating a black Hyundai as the sole occupant and was heading east on Dry Bridge rd, where she stopped at the posted stop sign. The driver of the Hyundai then proceeded to pull out into the intersection, entering into the path of an oncoming delivery truck that was heading west onto Golf Course road.

Both drivers were transported to CVPH. The female driver was being treated at CVPH where she later died. At the time of this release, the driver of the delivery truck was being evaluated at CVPH and is expected to be released.

The Clinton County Sheriff's Office is not releasing names of the parties involved at this time.

More information will be released at a later time.

The agencies that responded to the scene were the Clinton County Sheriff's Office, AuSable Forks Fire Department, AuSable Forks EMS, Keeseville Fire Department, Keeseville EMS and the New York State Police.

Update:

The Clinton County Sheriff's Office is issuing an update in regard to the fatal motor vehicle collision in Black Brook on 4/9/2026.

The female operator, Nancy L Guynup, 79 of Plattsburgh died as a result of blunt force trauma resulting from the accident. Guynup entered into the intersection of Dry Bridge Rd and Golf Course Road, directly in the path of an oncoming UPS Delivery vehicle operated by 46 year old Robert S Yu of Peru.

According to eye witness testimony, Guynup failed to identify the oncoming truck and entered into its path. Yu, attempted to avoid the collision, however struck Guynup's vehicle.

Clinton County Coroner Chad Deans directed an autopsy to be conducted at Glens Falls Hospital. The resulting preliminary cause of the death was determined to be Blunt Force Trauma.

There are no charges pending in this matter.
