**NARRATIVE** On April 30, 2023, Clinton County Sheriff's Deputies arrested Nathan J. Seller on the above-listed charges following a traffic stop in the Town of Plattsburgh. It's alleged Seller was operating a vehicle while in an intoxicated condition. Seller was also charged with Aggravated Unlicensed Operation 1<sup>st</sup> Degree due to his NYS license being currently suspended in connection with a previous conviction for Driving while Ability Impaired by Alcohol.

**DISPOSITION:** Seller was processed at the Sheriff's Office and released after being issued appearance tickets. He is set to appear in Plattsburgh Town Court in May.
