NARRATIVE: On July 6th, 2025, Clinton County Sheriff Deputies responded to a report of a one car motor vehicle collision with personal injury on Brand Hollow Road in the Town of Peru. Investigation on scene determined that Christopher Reil (25M/Altona, NY) was operating a 2017 Honda CRV, as the sole occupant, traveling eastbound on Brand Hollow Road in the Town of Peru at a high rate of speed, recklessly driving his vehicle and failing to keep right which led to the vehicle going off the roadway.

DISPOSITION: Christopher Reil was transported to the University of Vermont, Champlain Valley Physicians Hospital for treatment of severe injuries. Christopher was issued Uniform Traffic Tickets for Reckless Driving and other Vehicle and Traffic Law offenses. Reil may also have further charges pending investigation. Deputies were assisted on scene by Peru Fire Department, South Plattsburgh Fire Department, CVPH EMS and the New York State Police.
