NARRATIVE: On July 26, 2021, at 11:42AM, Clinton County Sheriff's Deputies responded to the intersection of Route 22B and Banker Road for the report of a two car motor vehicle accident with personal injury. Upon arrival, it was found that Nattassia Marshall was traveling west on Route 22B when Ann Tourville, travelling east on Route 22B, allegedly turned onto Banker Road, crossing in front of Marshall, failing to yield the right of way.

DISPOSITION: Marshall was evaluated by EMS on scene and transported to CVPH for further evaluation after a complaint of knee pain. Tourville was also evaluated by EMS on scene and transported to CVPH for further evaluation after a complaint of chest pain. At the time of press release, Tourville had been discharged and Marshall's status was not provided. Tourville was ticketed for Failing to Yield the Right of Way on Left Turn. The Sheriff's Office was assisted by Morrisonville EMS, Morrisonville Fire Department and District 3 Fire Department.
