NARRATIVE: On August 14, 2026, the Clinton County Sheriff's Office, with the assistance of the Northern Regional Special Response Team and multiple partner agencies, executed search warrants on residences located in the Town of Clinton and Town of Chazy related to an investigation into the sale and transportation of illegal controlled substances in Clinton County. As a result of the search warrant operations, the Clinton County Sheriff's Office located and arrested Francetta A. Jarvis on the above-listed charges. It's alleged that Jarvis was found to be in possession of a large amount of cocaine with the intent to sell. She is also alleged to have unlawfully possessed amounts of methamphetamine and oxycodone. The Sheriff's Office also seized six firearms during the operation. Jarvis is alleged to have unlawfully possessed the firearms due to a prior felony conviction.

DISPOSITION: Jarvis was transported to Clinton County Correctional Facility where she was committed pursuant to an active warrant for her arrest for allegedly violating the terms of her probation. Jarvis had been previously sentenced to felony probation following a March, 2025 conviction for Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance 4th Degree. She

is set to appear in Clinton Town Court on a later date in connection with the above-listed charges.

The Sheriff's Office was assisted by the Homeland Security Investigations (HSI), US Border Patrol, US Customs and Border Protection Air and Marine Operations -Plattsburgh Air Unit and the Plattsburgh City Police Department. The Northern Regional Special Response Team is comprised of members of the Clinton, Franklin, Essex, and St. Lawrence County Sheriff's Offices, as well as the Malone Village Police Department.
